

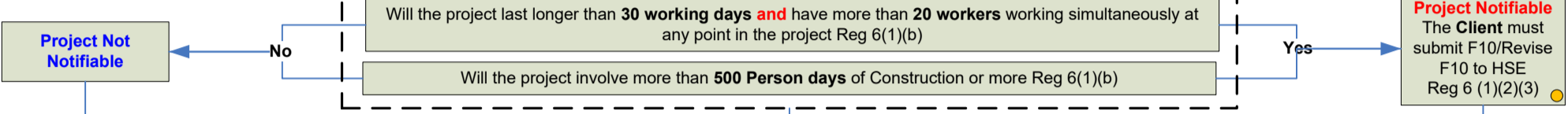

**PART 2 (Clients Duties) Construction Design & Management Regulations 2015 Applies (Regulation 4 – 7)**

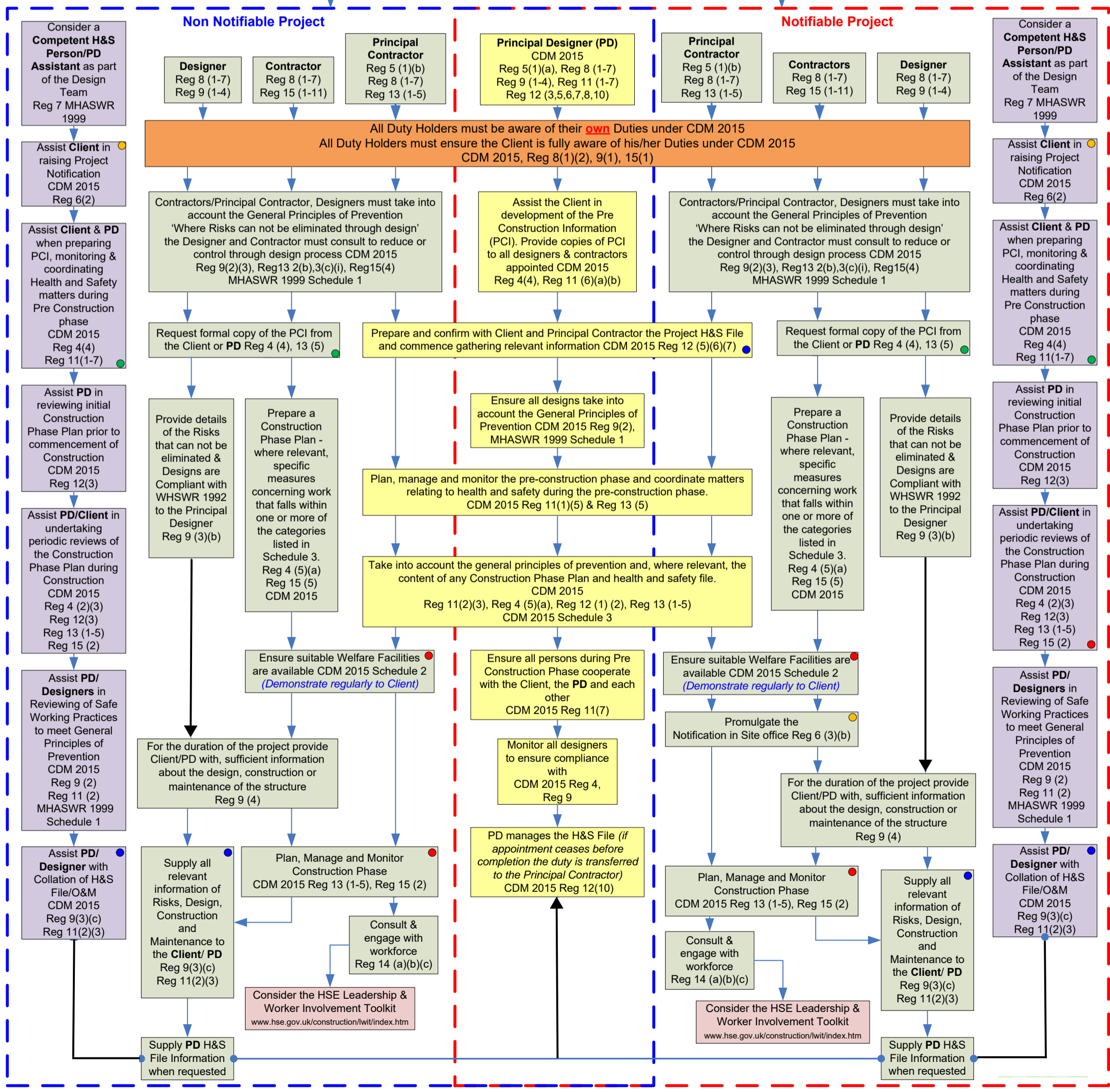
- The **Client** must make suitable arrangements for managing a project, including the allocation of sufficient time and other resources CDM 2015 Reg4(1)
- The **Client** must ensure Arrangements are suitable to carry out construction work SFARP without risk to H&S of anyone affected by the works and the welfare facilities required by Schedule 2 are provided in respect of any person carrying out construction work. The client must ensure that these arrangements are maintained and reviewed throughout the project. CDM 2015 Reg4(2)(a)(b), Reg 3
- Client** must provide PCI as soon as practicable to every designer and contractor appointed CDM 2015 Reg4(4)
- Client** must ensure a suitable Construction Phase Plan (CPP) is drawn up before work begins CDM 2015 Reg4(5)(a)
- Client** must ensure Principal Designer (where appointed) draws up a H&S File which complies with Reg 12(5) & its kept available and revised on a regular basis CDM 2015 Reg4(5)(b)(i)(ii)(iii)
- If a **Client** disposes of the client's interest in the structure, the client complies with the duty in paragraph (5)(b)(iii) by providing the H&S file new owner CDM 2015 Reg7
- Where **more than one Contractor** the Client formally appoints a Competent **Principal Designer (PD)** and they comply with their duties CDM 4(6)(a), Reg 5(1)(a)
- Where **more than one Contractor** the Client formally appoints a Competent **Principal Contractor** and they comply with their duties CDM 4(6)(b), Reg 5(1)(b)
